- Multi-sport company competition that promotes:

- Company pride



- An initial weekend of events confined to participating companies which provides the primary scoring mechanism
 - Points may also be earned toward a traveling title belt for participation and medals earned in the **Cornhusker State Games** and **NSC Mud Run**

When?

 - April 27-29, 2018



Competition Formats

All competitions are COED

- 4 men, 4 women competing
- Unique rosters are encouraged
- Players may compete in more than one sport, but only earn participation points once

Bowling



- **When:** Friday, April 27th – 6 p.m.
- **Where:** Sun Valley Lanes
- **Details:**
 - Shoe Rental is included
 - TWO 4-person teams per company
 - One game: Traditional scoring, total pins wins
 - Two games (or equivalent) – Alternate frame bowling in different combinations

Basketball



- **When:** Saturday, April 28th – 9 a.m.
- **Where:** Northstar High School
- **Details:**
 - COED 3v3 Full Court – Modified “Iowa H.S. Girls” format
 - Men vs. Men on one end, Women vs. Women on other end
 - Two 20-minute halves; 3-minute half-time
 - Pool play followed by seeded bracket

Cornhole



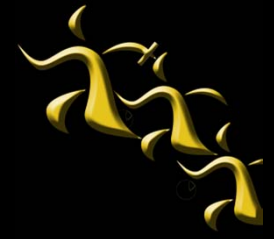
- **When:** Saturday, April 28th – 4 p.m.
- **Where:** Graduate Hotels – Lincoln, 141 S. 9th St.
- **Details:**
 - Companies form FOUR teams of 2 people (men/women) and number each team 1-4
 - Draw for seeding in a 16-team, two-way bracket competition
 - American Cornhole Association Rules
 - Matches consist of 4 games. Winner determined by:
 1. Games won
 2. Point Differential
 3. Sudden Death Corn-off

Volleyball



- **When:** Sunday, April 29th – 9 a.m.
- **Where:** Spikes Beach Bar & Grille
- **Details:**
 - 3 sets per match - rally scoring to 21
 - COED 6v6
 - Pool play followed by seeded bracket
 - Teams officiate for one another (scorekeeper, 1 net referee, 2 linesmen)

Relay Race



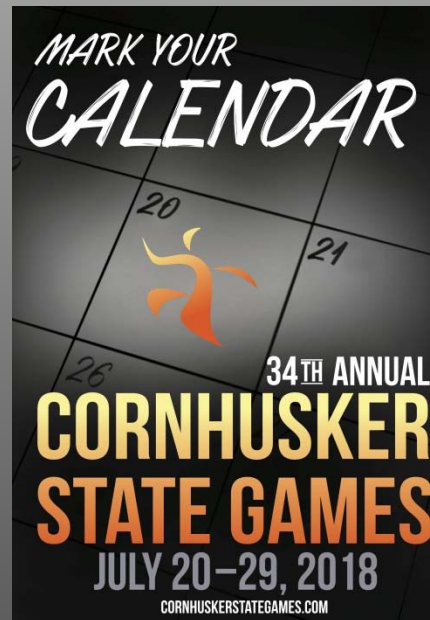
- **When:** Sunday, April 29th – 2 p.m.
- **Where:** Haymarket Park
- **Details:**
 - Companies form ONE team of 8 runners – 4 men/4 women per team
 - Relay lap race with .79 mile course
 - Teams run laps for 2.5 hours; no lap begins after 2.5 hour whistle
 - Teams MUST run in the same runner order
 - Winners determined by:
 1. Total laps
 2. Finish place on last lap
