


The Serve





1 serves to $3 \rightarrow 3$ must let it bounce (X) 3 returns to $2 \rightarrow 2$ must let it bounce (X) (or 3 returns to $1 \rightarrow 1$ must let it bounce)

After 2nd bounce, no further bounce reg'd.

	Serve Order	Score	Result	Positions
First serve of game	1 to 3	0-0-2	Serve team wins pt	1 and 2 switch sides and 1 continues serve
Second serve	1 to 4	1-0-2	Receive team wins pt	1 stays on left and 2 on the right.







The Non-Volley Zone (Kitchen)

- 1. You cannot hit a ball (volley) while you're standing in the NVZ (called "The Kitchen") unless the ball bounces first.
- 2. You can be in the kitchen at any time EXCEPT when hitting a volley (i.e. hitting a ball before it bounces).

Scoring:

- 1. only the serving team scores points
- 2. the serve is always cross-court
- 3. when a team wins the serve, the first serve is always from their right side
- 4. at the start of a game, the serving team gets one serve only
- 5. after the first serve of the game, both team members serve until they both lose points
- 6. the kitchen line is OUT on a serve; the side and end lines are IN
- 7. game is to 11 points -- the winning team must win by 2 points
- 8. score is announced in 3 digits. E.G.: 3-2-2
 - a) 1st digit is the servers' score; 2nd digit is receivers' score; 3rd digit designates if it is the 1st or 2nd server of the serving team.
